

EXPORT

Bilateral Agreements :

Second Textile Agreement has been signed between Bangladesh and the EEC on 11.7.82 for a period from 1.1.83 to 31.12.86. Under this Agreement the export of all textile/textile products(made-up) of Bangladesh are covered as under :-

Other measures.

All imported textile goods in their original or un-processed forms are banned for exports from Bangladesh. No other restriction is imposed in the export of textile and textile products from Bangladesh for any destination/destinations.

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
