### ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN TEXTILES

Notification under Article 4:4

Modification to the Bilateral Agreement between the EEC and Thailand

The Textiles Surveillance Body has received from the Commission of the European Communities a notification of a modification to the bilateral agreement between the EEC and Thailand, concluded under Article 4 of the MFA In this modification regional restraints were introduced for four categories.

The TSB, pursuant to its procedures regarding notifications under Article 4<sup>2</sup>, has examined the relevant documentation and is forwarding the text of the notification to participating countries for their information.

#### AGREED MINUTE

- A delegation of the Kingdom of Thailand and a delegation of the European Economic Community met on 26th and 27th August 1983 in Bangkok for consultations pursuant to Articles 8 and 17 of the Agreement on trade in textiles initialled on 7th July 1982.
- 2. As a result of these consultations, Thailand agreed to limit its exports of products falling under categories 158, 16,31 and 74 as follows:
  - (A) to the United Kingdom

#### 1. Category 15B

1983 205,000 pieces plus a special additional quantity of 39,000 pieces

1984 213,000 pieces

1985 222,000 pieces

1986 231,000 pieces

#### 2. Category 16

1983 111,000 pieces plus a special additional quantity of 30,000 pieces

1984 117,000 pieces

1985 122,000 pieces

1986 128,000 pieces

#### (B) to Ireland

#### 1. Category 31

1984 25,000 pieces

1985 27,000 pieces

1986 28,000 pieces

## 2. Category 74

1983 18,000 pieces plus a special additional quantity of 5,760 pieces

1984 19,000 pieces

1985 20,000 pieces

1986 21,000 pieces

3. It is the understanding of both parties that the quantities referred to as "special additional quantities" are provided to cover shipments before 31st December 1983 under contracts already concluded.

4. It is likewise agreed that the provisions of the Agreement which concern exports of products subject to quantitative limits established in Annex II of the Agreement shall apply to the exports referred to above from 1st January 1983.
