### NOTES

**MEXICO** 

Lines 28-44: Annual production data for most of the apparel products listed

are collected every five years (publication lag: two years).

Line 51: Value added by the apparel industry collected every five years

only.

AUSTRALIA

Line 5: For a few items trade is reported in weight and linear units.

Line 8: With the exception of a few products.

Lines 17 & 22: MF fabrics continuous and discontinuous combined.

Line 49: Consumption of certain fibres available annually up to 1974-1975.

These data expected to be available quinquennially for subsequent

periods.

Lines 54-55: Quarterly statistics available by broad industry branches.

General Note:

Australia collects annual data on the number of textile machines installed showing the number of machines in production and idle during the year.

## JAPAN

Line 5: Except for knitted or crocheted fabrics and fents.

Line 8: For sarongs.

Line 24: Including elastic or rubberized fabrics (the production of which is

negligible).

Lines 33-34, 36-39: Except those for infants.

Line 40: Including coats shorter than 3/4 length.

Lines 50-51: Available only for years of census of manufacturing.

### General Note:

Comprehensive data on total production of textile goods is not available; these data are collected from the firms as follows:

Fibre	Firms which have more than 30 workers
Yarn	more than 20
Fabric	more than 10
Knitted	more than 20
Narrow fabric, lace	more than 10
Garment	more than 30
Other textile goods	more than 20.
