Addendum

Attached is a communication setting out amendments to the bilateral agreement of 16 July 1963 concluded between the Governments of Spain and the United States.

This information has been transmitted to the secretariat by the United States in accordance with Article 4 of the Long-Term Arrangement.

"The Governments of the United States and Spain have agreed to amend their bilateral agreement of 16 July 1963 concerning trade in cotton textiles as follows:

1. Grouped categories for certain fabrics

The separate export ceilings for categories 18/19, 22 and 24 through 27 may be combined under a group ceiling of 7,604,314 square yards provided that the following sub-ceilings are not exceeded:

Category	Sub-ceiling
18-19	4,257,000 square yards
22	2,100,000 square yards
Duck	750,000 square yards
Earkeloth	555,000 square yards
24	800,000 square yards
25, 27	350,000 square yards each

2. Categories 53 and 63

Ceilings of categories 53 and 63 are increased as follows:

Category	Ceiling
53	9,000 dozen
63	23,000 pounds

3. Aggregate ceiling

The foregoing adjustments in export ceilings for categories 18/19, 22, 24 through 27, 53 and 63 are established with the understanding that the aggregate ceiling in the bilateral agreement of 16 July 1963, amounting to 31,366,919 square yards, shall not be exceeded."
