LONG-TERM ARRANGEMENT REGARDING TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Bilateral Arrangement between Canada and Japan

The following text has been transmitted to the secretariat by the Government of Canada in accordance with Article 4 of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding Trade in Cotton Textiles.

In a bilateral arrangement pursuant to Article 4 of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, Canada and Japan have agreed on the following restraint levels to be applied by Japan on exports to Canada during the calendar year 1963. (These restraint levels generally provide for an increase of 3 per cent over the 1962 levels.)
