## LONG-TERM ARRANGEMENT REGARDING TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

### Invocation of the Long-Term Arrangement by the United States

#### Addendum

The following communications relating to the information set forth in document COT/7/Add.1 have been submitted to the Executive Secretary by the United States Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

Restraint currently in effect

#### Renewal of restraint

##### PAKISTAN (LTA participant)

"This is to inform you that on 30 October 1964, by aide-memoire, the United States Government informed the Government of Pakistan that it was renewing the restraint on category 22 at a level of 610,000 square yards for the twelve months commencing 31 October 1964. In accordance with the provisions of Annex B, paragraph 2, of the Long-Term Arrangement, the renewal level for category 22 includes a 5 per cent increase over the previous year's ceiling."

##### POLAND (Non-participant in the LTA)

"This is to inform you that by communication dated 27 November 1964, the United States Government informed the Government of Poland that it was renewing the restraints on four cotton textile categories for the twelve-month period beginning on 4 December 1964. In accordance with the provisions of Annex B, paragraph 3, of the Long-Term Arrangement, the renewal levels include increases over the previous year's ceilings, as follows:
