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## LONG-TERM ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

## Bilateral Arrangement between Denmark and Japan

The following summary of a bilateral arrangement between Denmark and Japan has been transmitted to the secretariat by the Government of Denmark.

In a bilateral arrangement entered into under the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles the Governments of Denmark and Japan have agreed that the Government of Japan for the period of five years from 1 January 1963 to 31 December 1967 shall exercise voluntary export control on the following items in the amounts respectively specified:
