LONG-TERM ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Arrangement Between the United States and Mexico

The secretariat has received from the United States the following Arrangement which has been concluded between the Governments of Mexico and the United States, under Article 4 of the Long-Term Arrangement:

"Under Article 4 of the Long-Term Arrangement, the Government of Mexico has entered into an Arrangement with the United States in which Mexico will limit exports in category 26 (carded fabrics, n.e.s.) to the United States to 1,000,000 square yards for the twelve-month period beginning 15 February 1964. In addition, Mexico will limit shipments of duck in category 26 to no more than 80 per cent of the exportable level for the entire category."
