Completed Restraint Action

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission.

I have been instructed to inform you, for the information of the Cotton Textiles Committee, that by note dated 16 December 1965 the United States Government requested the Government of Brazil to consult with regard to the resumption of restraint on United States imports of carded cotton yarn, singles (category 1) from Brazil in view of the substantial increase in the rate of shipments as indicated in COT/34/Add.1 of 21 January 1966. In that note, Brazil was asked to restrain its category 1 exports to the United States to 2 million pounds for the twelve-month period beginning on 16 December 1965. In order to accommodate Brazilian exporters, the United States agreed to authorize, on an exceptional one-time basis, the importation into the United States of 10 million pounds of category 1 yarn from Brazil for the period extending from 1 August 1965 to 31 July 1966, outside the restraint level.

We have received a note from the Brazilian Embassy dated 13 January 1966 informing us that the Government of Brazil accepts our proposal.
