Agreement between Canada and Greece

Addendum

Request for renewal of restraint

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian Mission.

I have the honour to advise that, as a result of the continuing threat of disruption to the Canadian market for cotton yarn produced for direct sale, the Canadian Government, acting in accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, has requested the Government of Greece to continue to apply export restraints on cotton yarn to Canada for a further twelve-month period ending 31 May 1966.

The Canadian Government is aware that the Government of Greece is not a participant of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles. Article 6(c) of the Arrangement, however, places an obligation on importing countries not to discriminate in favour of non-participants. Since two participating countries continue to restrain exports of cotton yarn to Canada, the Canadian Government has been obliged to request Greece to continue to limit exports of this product.
