The following communication relating to the information set forth in COT/37 page 2/3 has been transmitted to the Director-General by the Canadian Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that following recent consultations between the Canadian and Chinese authorities pursuant to the provisions of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, there have been a number of modifications in the products subject to restraint and the restraint levels that are to apply during the year ending 30 June 1966. The new restraint levels are listed below:
