The following communications have been received from the Governments of Australia and Sweden in connexion with their notifications under Article 2:

AUSTRALIA

"....A typographical error occured in our reply to question A 4(iii) of GATT/AIR/420 (reproduced in COT/40 page 2/3, fifth line), this should have read:

'No changes in restrictions or quotas are envisaged during the third year of the Arrangement.'"

SWEDEN

The Permanent Swedish Delegation requests that their notification reproduced in COT/40, page 6, he replaced by the following:

"The Swedish import quota for certain cotton textiles from Japan amounted during the period 1 April 1963-31 March 1964 to 3.5 million Swedish Kronor (0.7 million US dollars). This quota was partly made up of cotton gauze and cotton carpets, not knitted, corresponding to an import value of approximately 0.5 million Swedish Kronor (0.1 million US dollars).

"On 1 April 1964, imports from Japan of cotton gauze and cotton carpets, not knitted, were liberalized. Thus, the quota of 3.5 million Swedish Kronor now does not cover these articles. It follows that Sweden has extended the scope for imports of cotton textiles subject to restrictions considerably beyond the limits envisaged in the Long-Term Arrangement on Cotton Textiles."
