Bilateral Arrangement Between Canada and Japan

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that Canada has concluded an Arrangement with Japan for the year 1969 concerning restraints on exports of certain cotton textiles from Japan to Canada.

Restraints to be Applied by Japan on Exports of Certain Cotton Textile Products to Canada for the Calendar Year 1969

Blouses	218,463 dozen
Shirts	281,548 dozen
Trousers and outer shorts	128,369 dozen
Pillowcases	228,094 dozen
Sheets	812,670 pieces
Fabrics	33,299,700 square yards

(Within the overall quota for fabrics, dyed corduroy may not exceed 2,121,000 square yards.)
