LONG-TERM ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL
TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Requests for Restraint Made by Italy in Accordance
with Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Italian permanent mission.

I have the honour to inform you that, by Notes Verbales dated 14 December 1965, the Italian Government has invited the Government of the United Kingdom and the Government of Portugal to enter into consultations concerning imports into Italy of cotton bed linen, table linen, toilet linen and kitchen linen, with embroidery, tulle or openwork (tariff heading 62.02.03, 62.02.04 and 62.02.06) from Hong Kong and Timor.

These consultations have been requested in pursuance of Article 3 of the Long-Term Arrangement on International Trade in Cotton Textiles (for imports from Hong Kong) and in pursuance of Article 6, paragraph (c) of that Arrangement (for imports from Timor).
