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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Restraints under Article 3

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that, acting in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, the Governments of Canada and Korea reached agreement on the cotton textile products and the restraint levels to be applied to these products during calendar year 1968. These are as follows:

Broadwoven fabrics:	2,884,000	Square yards
(a) other than grey may not exceed	430,000	Square yards
(b) corduroy may not exceed	107,000	Square yards
Yarn and sewing thread	200,000	Pounds
Pillowcases	32,000	Dozens
Sheets	42,000	Units
Garments	128,750	Dozens
of which:		
(a) woven shirts may not exceed	36,800	Dozens
(b) blouses may not exceed	20,000	Dozens
(c) knitted shirts may not exceed	20,200	Dozens
(d) sleepwear may not exceed	21,500	Dozens
(e) trousers, slacks and shorts may not exceed	51,500	Dozens
