Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that, acting in accordance with the provisions of Article 3 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, the Governments of Canada and the Republic of Korea reached agreement on the restraint levels to be applied to exports from Korea to Canada of certain cotton textile products during the calendar year 1969. These are as follows:
