ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action Taken by the United States Under Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States Mission:

There follows, for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee, a summary statement of the action reuntly taken by the Government of the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles in relation to restraint of cotton textile exports from Hungary to the United States.

On 25 March 1968 the Government of the United States of America requested consultations with the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic on cotton textile Category 26. On 7 June 1968, in the absence of an agreement, the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic was notified that the United States Bureau of Customs had been requested to limit to 320,000 square yards the quantity of cotton textiles (other than duck) exported from Hungary after 25 March 1968 that may enter the United States during the twelve months beginning on that date.
