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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL
TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action taken by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 13 March 1969, the United States Government requested the Government of the Hungarian People's Republic to renew the restraint on Category 26 cotton textiles (other than duck) exported from Hungary¹ to the United States. The original request for restraint was made on 25 March 1968, pursuant to Long-Term Arrangement Articles 3 and 6(c). The restraint level for the twelve months ending 25 March 1970, will be 336,000 square yards, which includes a growth factor of 5 per cent over the previously prevailing level.
