Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 18 March 1969, the United States Government requested the Government of Malaysia to renew the restraint on Category 50 cotton textiles (men's and boys' slacks, trousers, etc.) exported from Malaysia to the United States. The original request for restraint was made on 12 March 1967, pursuant to Long-Term Arrangement Articles 3 and 6(c) and was renewed on 21 March 1968. The restraint level for the twelve months ending 20 March 1970, will be 5,513 dozen, which includes a growth factor of 5 per cent over the previously prevailing level.
