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## ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

### Action Taken by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

#### Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 17 March 1970 the United States Government requested the Government of Malaysia<sup>1</sup> to renew the restraint on exports from Malaysia to the United States of men's and boys' cotton trousers, slacks, and outer shorts, not knit (Cotton Textile Category 50). The original request was made on 21 March 1967.

The new restraint period covers the twelve months beginning 21 March. The new restraint level (including a growth factor of 5 per cent over the previously prevailing level) is 5,798 dozen.
