ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Agreement between Australia and Hong Kong

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Permanent Mission of Australia for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I refer to the notification conveyed to contracting parties in COT/104/Add.l and Add.2 of 22 May and 10 July 1969 respectively.

- 2. Following consultations in Hong Kong, the Hong Kong Government has agreed to restrain exports of cotton drills (other than grey) weighing not less than 6 ounces per square yard and not more than 15 ounces per square yard, to a limit of 950,000 square yards during the period 1 July 1969 to 30 June 1970.
- 3. The Australia Government has decided not to pursue at this stage its request for restraint on garage cotton drills, cotton jeans, cotton denims, and cotton dungarees, weighing not less than 6 ounces per square yard and not more than 15 ounces per square yard.
