ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE
IN COTTON TEXTILES

Restraint Action by the United States in
Accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

The United States Government, acting in accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, will limit imports of carded cotton sheets (Category 34) from Rumania to a level of 147,000 pieces for the twelve months beginning 14 August 1968. This action and the specified control level apply to goods exported from Rumania on or after that date and through 13 August 1969. A directive to the United States Bureau of Customs covering these points was published in the Federal Register of 21 August 1968. This action constitutes a renewal of the restraint action taken on 14 August 1967. The new restraint level includes 5 per cent growth over the level of 140,000 pieces established at that time.
