ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Restraint Action by the United States in Accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

The United States Government, acting in accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, has renewed the restraints on Argentine exports to the United States of category 9 (carded cotton sheeting) at 638,141 square yards for the twelve-month period which began on 19 July 1969. The original restraint action covered the one-year period which began 18 July 1968.¹ The present level of restraint is 5 per cent above the level for the previous year.
