RESTRICTED

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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

The following notification has been received by the Director-General from the United Kingdom mission:

Details of current United Kingdom import arrangements for cotton textiles from restricted sources are set out in the following paper for the information of the Cotton Textiles Committee. These import arrangements take account of a further increase of 1 per cent introduced on 1 January 1968.

Arrangements Relating to Exports of Cotton Textiles to the United Kingdom

I. The following is a summary of the arrangements as at 31 August 1968 for the control of exports of cotton spun or woven textile goods for retention in the United Kingdom during 1968 from the countries listed below.

Hong Kong

Exports of cotton textiles from Hong Kong to the United Kingdom will be limited to the following amounts:

India

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Eastern area countries and the People's Republic of China

The United Kingdom limits imports of cotton textiles from the USSR; Poland; Hungary; Rumania; Bulgaria; East Germany; Czechoslovakia; and the People's Republic of China. The restrictions apply to:

Cotton yarn piece-goods and made-up goods; the total annual quotas are worth a little over £2 million.
