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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Arrangement between Canada and Malaysia

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that following consultations held pursuant to the provisions of Article 6 of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, the Governments of Canada and Malaysia, by a Memorandum of Understanding signed on 18 December 1969, have amended the provisions relating to shirts set out in the Memorandum of Understanding dated 16 October 1968.

The Governments of Canada and Malaysia agree that exports of cotton, polyester/cotton and polyester/polynosic shirts from Malaysia to Canada will be limited to the levels shown in the attached Annex during the periods set out therein.

The provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding of 16 October 1968¹, that relate to cotton and polyester/cotton trousers (including slacks, shorts and jeans) continue in effect and the restraint levels have been reproduced in the Annex.
