ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action Taken by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee:

"Through an exchange of notes in 1967, the United States Government and the Government of Tunisia agreed that the import of cotton duck into the United States from Tunisia should not exceed 320,000 square yards for calendar year 1968. This agreement was reached in pursuance of Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles.

"Since there were no imports of cotton duck from Tunisia in 1968, the United States Government has informed the Government of Tunisia that it considered that the restraint in effect or this category during 1968 need not be renewed."
