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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL
TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action taken by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 27 February 1969 (retroactive to 31 October 1968), the United States Government placed imports from Honduras¹ in cotton textile Category 61 under import control at an annual restraint level of 30,000 dozen. This level is in accordance with the formula in Annex B of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, which provides that restraints may not be set at a level less than the actual level of imports of the products concerned during the twelve-month period terminating three months preceding the month in which the request is made.
