

GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

RESTRICTED

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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action taken by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

The United States Government, acting in accordance with Articles 3 and 6(c) of the Long-Term Arrangement for International Trade in Cotton Textiles, is limiting to a level of 20,000 dozen imports of Category 52 (blouses, not knit) which are exported from Trinidad and Tobago during the twelve-month period 24 December 1968 through 23 December 1969. A directive to the United States Bureau of Customs covering these points became effective 28 March 1969.
