ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States Mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

The United States on 23 March 1970 renewed the Article 3 restraints on products in cotton textile categories 26 (other than duck) and 19 exported from Hungary¹ to the United States.

In category 26 (other than duck) the restraint was renewed at a level of 352,800 square yards for the twelve-month period beginning 25 March 1970. In category 19, the restraint was renewed at a level of 525,000 square yards for the twelve-month period beginning April 1970. The levels are 5 per cent higher than the levels applicable for the preceding twelve-month periods.
