Action by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 27 February 1970, the United States Government requested the Government of Malaysia to renew restraints on emorts from Malaysia to the United States of cotton textiles in Categories 49 (coats, not knit, other than raincoats 3/4 length or longer) and 55 (dressing gowns, including bathrobes, beach robes, lounge robes, and housecoats and dusters - not knit). The original request was made 28 February 1969.

The new restraint period covers the twelve months beginning 28 February 1970. The new restraint levels (including a growth factor of 5 per cent over previously prevailing levels) are 1,785 dozen for Category 49 and 17,325 dozen for Category 55.
