ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 15 May 1970, the United States Government requested the Government of Malaysia¹ to renew the restraint on exports from Malaysia to the United States of carded twill and sateen (Cotton Textile Category 22). The original request was made on 24 May 1967.

The new restraint covers the twelve months beginning 24 May 1970. The new restraint level (including a growth factor of 5 per cent over the previously prevailing level) is 254,678 square yards.
