ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

Addendum

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committe¹.

On 26 March 1970, the United States Government, under the provisions of the Long-Term Arrangement involving non-Long-Term Arrangement members, renewed the restraints on imports from Brazil¹, exported during the twelve-month period which began 27 March 1970, in Category 31 (towels, other than dish) and Category 64 (all other cotton textile items), at levels of 1,575,000 pieces and 84,000 pounds respectively. These levels reflected a 5 per cent increase over the previous year's levels.
