

GENERAL AGREEMENT ON TARIFFS AND TRADE

RESTRICTED

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ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Action by the United States under Articles 3 and 6(c)

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the United States mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

On 30 March 1970, the United States Government, under the provisions of the Long-Term Arrangement involving non-Long-Term Arrangement members, imposed a restraint on imports from the Socialist Republic of Romania¹, exported during the twelve-month period which began 27 January 1970, in Category 50 (trousers, men and boys not knit), at a level of 15,000 dozen. On 23 December 1969, the United States Government imposed a restraint on imports from the Socialist Republic of Romania, exported during the twelve-month period which began 31 October 1969, in Category 63 (other clothing, not knit), at a level of 200,000 pounds.
