ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Restraint Action by Canada under Article 3

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

I have the honour to advise you that following consultations between the Governments of Mexico and Canada, and in accordance with the provisions of the Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles, an agreement has been concluded between both countries under which the Government of Mexico has agreed to limit exports of cotton yarn to Canada to a monthly level of 152,000 pounds during the period 1 October 1970 to 31 March 1971 with a single ex-quota amount of 66,000 pounds which can be exported during the period in question as and when convenient to the Government of Mexico.
