ARRANGEMENT REGARDING INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN COTTON TEXTILES

Restraint Action by Canada under Article 3

The following communication has been received by the Director-General from the Canadian mission for notification to the Cotton Textiles Committee.

Following recent consultations between representatives of the Governments of Mexico and Canada, the Government of Mexico has undertaken to limit exports of cotton yarn to Canada to a monthly level of 152,000 pounds during an interim period from 1 March to 30 September 1970.¹ In addition, it was agreed that a single ex-quota amount of 76,000 pounds may be exported during the period specified.
