Basic Statistics on Cotton Textiles

1. The Cotton Textiles Committee at its meeting 2-6 December 1963 recognized the need for comparable and up-to-date statistical data on cotton textiles. In this connexion it was pointed out that while some statistics were already collected and published by other international agencies, certain important data could not be found in these sources. It was furthermore noted that up-to-date information could only be obtained directly from countries parties to the Arrangement. The Committee endorsed the suggestions made in document COT/W/14 and urged all participating countries to endeavour to submit the necessary statistics in order to enable the secretariat to carry out effectively the statistical programme. It was agreed that, if possible, a standard lay-out should be used by all countries, but all members should be consulted prior to its adoption (see document L/2135 - COT/M/3, pages 5 and 15).

2. Accordingly, enquiry forms for quarterly and yearly submissions have been designed provisionally by the secretariat and are attached herewith. The quarterly form asks for data on trade and production for the third and fourth quarters 1963; the yearly form requests data on consumption for 1963. These forms supersede the questionnaires contained in document COT/W/8 dated 13 December 1962.

3. Participating countries are requested to endeavour to fill in the two preliminary enquiry forms and return them to the secretariat as soon as possible and in any case no later than 1 June 1964, even if all data are not available by that date. Countries are further requested to submit comments on the forms themselves and to give an indication as to the period needed for the completion of quarterly and yearly data.

4. In the light of the comments received, the secretariat will design final enquiry forms which will be distributed regularly. It is the intention of the secretariat to consolidate the replies and issue statistics on a quarterly and on a yearly basis.

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5. As regards statistics so far submitted in response to the questionnaires included in document COT/W/8, the secretariat has rearranged them in accordance with the attached enquiry forms. A set of tables containing these data will shortly be sent directly to the submitting agencies in each country for revision and completion where necessary.

6. Those participating countries which have not yet submitted any statistics on foreign trade and production are requested to send the secretariat, in addition to the data asked for in the attached enquiry forms, statistics for the preceding periods (calendar years 1961 and 1962, fourth quarter 1962 and the first two quarters of 1963). These data should also be presented in accordance with the lay-out of the enquiry forms.

Statistics on Foreign Trade in and Production of Cotton Textiles

Quarterly Submissions

Statistical information on cotton textiles is required by the Cotton Textiles Committee for the discharge of its functions. Participating countries are therefore requested in accordance with Article 8 of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles to complete the attached enquiry forms and to return them to the secretariat as soon as possible. Where necessary, data submitted in earlier replies should be revised.

According to Article 9 of the Arrangement, the expression "cotton textiles" includes yarns, piece-goods, made-up articles, garments, and other textile manufactured products in which cotton represents more than 50 per cent (by weight) of the fibre content, with the exception of hand-loom fabrics of the cottage industry. Should the data reported not comply with these specifications, detailed definitions should be supplied.

In order to distinguish the various groups of cotton textiles on which data are required, references are made on the enquiry forms to the United Nations Standard International Trade Classification, Revised (SITC) and to the Tariff Nomenclature of the Customs Co-operation Council (BTN).¹ If these definitions are not followed, the definitions used should be specified.

Quantities and values should, if possible, be submitted in metric tens and thousand United States dollars. In all cases, the unit used should be specified. Where units of quantity other than weight, such as length, surface measurements and numbers, are applied, a factor for conversion into weight should be suggested. It should be indicated whether the trade values reported are at f.o.b. or c.i.f. prices.

Import data should, if possible, relate to retained imports. Should this not be possible, quantity and value of re-exports should be given separately for each commodity group reported where re-exports are of any significance. In all cases the system of reporting (for instance, general or special trade) should be clearly indicated.

In the analysis by provenance and destination all countries which are party to the Long-Term Arrangement should be shown separately. As regards trade with "other countries", investigation has shown that it would be difficult to establish a standard cut-off point to be applied by all participating countries. Data should be supplied for all countries listed in the enquiry forms as well as for up to six other trading partners considered by each participating country to be of importance to its trade. These additional countries should as far as possible be the same from one submission to the next.

The production data should include yarn and fabrics of cotton made in the cotton as well as in the other sectors of the textile industries. In order to avoid double counting, the figures for yarn should represent single yarn; those on fabrics should relate to fabrics at loom stage.

Yearly Submissions

Statistical information on cotton textiles is required by the Cotton Textiles Committee for the discharge of its functions. Participating countries are therefore requested in accordance with Article 8 of the Long-Term Arrangement Regarding International Trade in Cotton Textiles to complete the attached enquiry form and to return it to the secretariat <u>as soon as possible</u>. Where necessary, data submitted in earlier replies should be revised.

In accordance with Article 9 of the Arrangement, yarns and fabrics shall be included when cotton represents more than 50 per cent (by weight) of the fibre content, with the exception of hand-loom fabrics of the cottage industry. Should the data reported not comply with these specifications, detailed definitions should be supplied.

Quantities should, if possible, be submitted in metric tons. In all cases, the unit used should be specified. Where units of quantity other than weight, such as length, surface measurements and numbers, are applied, a factor for conversion into weight should be suggested.

The following symbols should be applied:

- .. not available
- nil or negligible
- () provisional figure, subject to revision.
