INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION TO FACILITATE THE IMPORTATION OF COMMERCIAL SAMPLES AND ADVERTISING MATERIAL

Corrigendum

Paragraph 1 of Article IV of the Convention annexed to the Report was incorrectly set out. The text of the paragraph and the indentation should be as follows:

"1. Each Contracting Party shall exempt from import duties catalogues, price-lists and trade notices relating to:-

- (a) goods offered for sale or hire; or
- (b) transport or commercial insurance services offered

by a person established in the territory of another Contracting Party, when such documents are imported from the territory of any Contracting Party, provided that each consignment imported either:-

- (i) consists of not more than one document; or
- (ii) if it consists of more than one document, does not include more than one copy of any one document; or
- (iii) irrespective of the number of documents or copies, does not exceed 1 kilogram in gross weight.

Simultaneous despatch of a number of consignments to different addresses in the territory of importation shall not debar such consignments from this exemption, provided that not more than one consignment is sent to any one consignee."
