Addendum

Accession by India

The Secretary-General of the United Nations has advised that an Instrument of Accession to the Convention was deposited, in accordance with the provisions of Article X of the Convention, by the Indian Government on 3 August 1954.

In this Instrument of Accession the Government of India "reserve and stipulate the following condition to the acceptance of Article IV of the said Convention by the Government of India" :

"The concession of duty-free import would be available to only those catalogues, price-lists and trade notices which are supplied free."

This reservation will be dealt with in accordance with Article XIV of the Convention. Accordingly the Secretary-General of the United Nations has informed all Governments which are, or may become, parties to the Convention.
