THIRD CERTIFICATION OF RECTIFICATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS

Schedule XIII - New Zealand

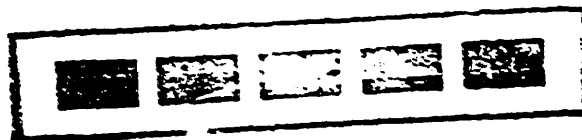
A new customs tariff of New Zealand, the nomenclature of which is in the form of the Standard International Trade Classification, entered into force on 1 July 1962.

As many of the rates of duty were changed in connexion with the introduction of the new tariff, renegotiation of New Zealand's Schedule of concessions was necessary. On 4 June 1960 the CONTRACTING PARTIES granted a waiver to New Zealand (BISD, 9th Supplement, page 42) to enable the new tariff to be introduced before completion of the negotiations for the modifications and withdrawals involved in Schedule XIII.

On 20 August 1965 New Zealand reported that the renegotiations under the waiver had been completed (SECRET/123/Add.20).

The Government of New Zealand has now submitted a draft new Schedule XIII embodying the results of the renegotiations. Two copies of the draft Schedule are being sent to each contracting party.

If no objections are notified to the secretariat by thirty days from the date of this document, the new Schedule XIII - New Zealand will be considered to have been approved and will be incorporated in the Third Certification of Rectifications and Modifications.
