IMPORT RESTRICTIONS OF ICELAND

Liberalization Effective January 1966

The Government of Iceland has advised that effective 21 January 1966 additional commodities have been placed on the list of liberalized commodities. Global quotas for imports in 1966 have also been increased from a total of IKr.82.8 million announced for 1965 to a total of IKr.155.2 million, and the latter figure is 41 per cent above actual imports in 1965 of goods subject to quota. The list of commodities recently liberalized and global quotas for 1966 are shown below.
