### Addendum

#### List of Goods Not Subject to Import Deposit<sup>1</sup>

The United Kingdom delegation has submitted the following list of goods excepted from the requirement of import deposit which was notified in L/3140. Deposit applies at the rate of 50 per cent ad valorem to all imported goods except those listed in this Notice. The deposit is repayable after 180 days.

This list is in terms of the Customs Tariff in force on 1 July 1968.
