ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO THE UNCTAD BOARD AND TO THE COMMITTEE ON COMMODITIES

Note by the Director-General

In September 1968 the Council of Representatives proposed Mr. Osman Ali, of Pakistan, as the nominee of the CONTRACTING PARTIES on the Advisory Committee to the UNCTAD Board and to the Committee on Commodities. At the meeting of the Trade and Development Board on 7 February, Mr. Osman Ali was elected Chairman of the Advisory Committee and, consequently, the Secretary-General of UNCTAD has now requested the CONTRACTING PARTIES to nominate a person to replace Mr. Osman Ali as member of the Advisory Committee for the period ending 14 February 1972.

- 4. Mr. Tulio de Andrea (Peru), non-agricultural commodities
- 5. Mr. I. Frank (United States), development problems
- 6. Mr. D.I. Kostyukhin (USSR), State trading
- 7. Mr. A. Philip (France), major consuming countries

The request of the Secretary-General will be referred to the Council of Representatives at its next meeting. Meanwhile, any contracting party wishing to propose a candidate for nomination should submit to me his name and curriculum vitae.
