SCHEDULE VII - CHILE

Withdrawal of Concessions under Article XXVII

The following communication has been received from the permanent delegation of Chile.

I have the honour to inform you that in accordance with the provisions of Article XXVII of the General Agreement, the Government of Chile has decided to withdraw the following concessions provided for in Schedule VII as negotiated initially with Colombia during the Tariff Conference held at Annecy in 1949:

In communicating the above, and requesting you to be good enough to bring it to the notice of the CONTRACTING PARTIES, I should like to inform you that my delegation is prepared in the course of the current negotiations under Article XXVIII for the modification or withdrawal of concessions provided for in Schedule VII (Chile), to consider any substantial interest expressed by a country Member of GATT in relation to the products in question.
