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NOTIFICATIONS OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS APPLIED INCONSISTENTLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF GATT AND NOT COVERED BY WAIVERS

Addendum

SOUTH AFRICA

The following communication, dated 12 January 1970, together with the attached notification of South Africa's residual import restrictions, has been received from the Permanent Representative of South Africa.

In accordance with Section B, paragraph 7 of the procedures relating to residual import restrictions, approved by the CONTRACTING PARTIES on 16 November 1960 (BISD, Ninth Supplement, page 18), I enclose three copies of a notification by the South African Government.

In amplification of the statement made in paragraph 5 of my letter of 19 December 1969 (see document L/3277/Add.1), I am directed to advise you that the South African Government is at present engaged in a full-scale revision of its remaining import restrictions with a view to determining which of these restrictions can be progressively dismantled without causing disruption of activity in certain sectors of the South African economy. It is the South African Government's intention to proceed with the liberalization of these controls as soon as the present survey has been completed.

This measure of liberalization will consist of the transfer of certain commodities which at present are subject to import permit but for which the full reasonable requirements of importers are met (see Annex B of my letter of 19 December 1969), to the list of goods which may be imported without permit as well as the transfer of certain goods from Annex C (those goods which are subject to special quotas) to Annex B. This procedure will be continued in subsequent liberalization moves. Details of these relaxations of South Africa's import restrictions will be communicated to you from time to time.

NOTIFICATION OF IMPORT RESTRICTIONS APPLIED INCONSISTENTLY WITH THE PROVISIONS OF GATT AND NOT COVERED BY WAIVERS

The following notification is submitted to the CONTRACTING PARTIES by the South African Government in terms of Section B, paragraph 7, of the procedures relating to residual import restrictions approved by the CONTRACTING PARTIES on 16 November 1960 (BISD, Ninth Supplement, page 18).

The products listed in Annexes A and B to this notification are subject, on importation into South Africa, to restrictions maintained contrary to the provisions of the General Agreement and without authorization from the CONTRACTING PARTIES.

A list of commodities which may be imported into South Africa without an import permit may be found in Annex A to the list of restrictions contained in L/3277/Add.l. In addition to the items there listed it should also be noted that personal effects (excluding motor vehicles) imported for their own use by individuals intending to reside temporarily or as immigrants in South Africa, bona fide gifts not exceeding R 10 in value, samples of no commercial value and certain other categories of goods of the kinds customarily permitted free entry may likewise be imported without permit.

Permits for the importation of the classes and kinds of goods specified in Annexes A and B are granted on the following bases:

Annex A: Fermits are granted on application to bona fide merchants and manufacturers to meet their full reasonable requirements.

Annex B: Fermits are granted to individual importers in accordance with quotas determined from time to time.

South Africa's import restrictions do not distinguish between sources of supply. Permits are valid for the importation of goods from any country.

There is also attached, as <u>Annex C</u> to this notification, a list of commodities which may be imported into South Africa without an import permit.

South Africa proposes to move forward as rapidly as possible with the dismantling of its remaining restrictions. Reports on the progress made will be submitted to the CONTRACTING PARTIES.

ANNEX A

 - (xvi) all classes and kinds of goods not specified elsewhere in Annex B or free from quantitative import restrictions (see L/3277/Add.1, Annex A).
