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## RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORTS FROM POLAND

### Notifications by Contracting Parties

#### Addendum

1. Notifications submitted by twelve contracting parties on restrictions on imports from Poland were circulated in document L/3241, dated 25 August 1969.
2. Notifications have subsequently been received from the following Governments:
  - Austria
  - Burma
  - Canada
  - Switzerland
  - United Kingdom

These notifications are reproduced hereunder.

3. Contracting parties, which have not yet submitted notifications, are invited to do so without delay. It was indicated in airgram GATT/AIR/718 that governments which had already notified their restrictions in connexion with the first review under the Protocol, as restrictions applied contrary to GATT or as restrictions maintained for balance-of-payments reasons, would only be required to refer to their previous notifications, to the extent that these fulfilled the particular requirements laid down in GATT/AIR/718.

#### AUSTRIA

With reference to GATT/AIR/718 dated 13 May 1969 I have the honour to submit three lists of products which Austria has liberalized vis-à-vis Poland.

List No. 1 contains those products which have been liberalized vis-à-vis Poland on 30 June 1967.

List Nos. 2 and 3 contain those products which Austria has liberalized vis-à-vis Poland since the last Austrian notification (see BISD, Sixteenth Supplement, page 74). The products contained in List No. 2 can be imported from Poland into Austria without any quantitative restrictions. The products contained in List No. 3 are subject to quantitative restrictions, if they are imported from Poland, but the quotas established from time to time can be overdrawn in principle.

BURMA

I am directed to inform you that Burma does not impose any restrictions of the kind referred to in paragraph 3 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland.

CANADA

Canada does not maintain import restrictions inconsistent with Article XIII against Poland.

SWITZERLAND

We wish to inform you that the Swiss notification dated 14 May 1968 (BISD, Sixteenth Supplement, pages 78-79) regarding commercial policy measures towards Poland still remains wholly valid.

UNITED KINGDOM

The restrictions in force on 30 June 1967 on imports into the United Kingdom from Poland were listed in Annex A to the United Kingdom's notification made in connexion with the First Annual Review (reproduced in Annex V to L/3093). The differential treatment applied to imports from Poland was explained in the covering note.

Annex B to the notification gave details of the quotas in force in 1967 and Annex C those in force in 1968. Quotas for 1969 were agreed in consultation with a delegation of the Polish Government at talks held in London in July 1969 and details are set out in the enclosure to this notification. No changes have been made since the earlier notification in the list of items which can be imported freely into the United Kingdom from Poland.

For the year ending 31 December 1969, the following quotas have been increased by the amounts shown. In some cases quotas have been made less restrictive by the elimination of items from inner limits:
