Addendum

I

The delegation of <u>Brazil</u> has informed the secretariat that Brazil - as was notified in connexion with the previous consultation in 1968 - does not maintain any restrictions of the kind envisaged in paragraph 3 of the Protocol for the Accession of Poland.

The introductory part of the notification by <u>Austria</u>, reproduced on page 1 of document L/3241/Add.1, should read as follows:

"With reference to GATT/AIR/718 dated 13 May 1969 I have the honour to submit three lists of products which Austria has liberalized vis-à-vis Poland.

"<u>List No. 1</u> contains those products which have been liberalized vis-à-vis Poland before the last Austrian notification (see BISD, Sixteenth Supplement, page 74).

"Lists Nos. 2 and 3 contain those products which Austria has liberalized vis-a-vis Poland since the last Austrian notification.

"The products contained in <u>Lists Nos. 1 and 2</u> can be imported from Poland into Austria without any quantitative restrictions. The products contained in <u>List No. 3</u> are subject to quotas established from time to time. These quotas can be overdrawn in principle."

III

In the notification submitted by <u>Finland</u> and reproduced in document L/3241, there are lists of imports completely liberated from licensing and imports wholly or partly subject to licensing. These lists indicate imports under whole chapters in the Brussels Nomenclature. Lists showing imports from Poland under each separate tariff heading have also been transmitted to the secretariat and can be consulted in the secretariat offices.
