SECOND CERTIFICATION OF CHANGES TO SCHEDULES

Schedule LVIII - Malawi

The Government of Malawi was deemed to be a contracting party under the provisions of Article XXVI:5(c) as from 6 July 1964 (document L/2258). The concessions specified in Schedule XVI - Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland constituted from that time the Schedule of Concessions of Malawi.

Schedule LVIII - Malawi was subsequently formally established through the certification procedure (L/2847, L/3202 and L/3232).

In the meantime, the CONTRACTING PARTIES decided on 20 November 1967 (BISD, Fifteenth Supplement, page 89) to suspend the application of Articles I and II of the General Agreement to the extent necessary to enable the Government of Malawi to apply new rates of duty, pending the examination by the CONTRACTING PARTIES of the margins of preference in the new customs tariff and the conclusion of renegotiations for the modification or withdrawal of concessions in Schedule LVIII - Malawi.

The Government of Malawi has concluded the negotiations and consultations with the contracting parties primarily concerned or having a substantial interest in the concessions modified or withdrawn (cf document C/M/55, page 3).

The new Schedule LVIII - Malawi, of which two copies are being sent to each contracting party, is a consolidated schedule which incorporates:

- (a) the Schedule of Malawi corresponding to Schedule XVI Federation of Rhodesia and Nyasaland as resulting from the renegotiations under the Decision by the CONTRACTING PARTIES of 20 November 1967, and
- (b) the Schedule of Malawi annexed to the Geneva (1967) Protocol, which Schedule was not affected by the renegotiations under the Decision of 20 November 1967.

If no objections are notified to the secretariat by 31 October 1969, the consolidated Schedule LVIII - Malawi will be considered to have been approved and will be incorporated in the Second Certification of Changes to Schedules.
