IMPORTS OF BEEF INTO THE UNITED KINGDOM

Addendum

The following communication has been received from the delegation of Uruguay.

The permanent delegation of Uruguay to GATT has the honour to inform the GATT secretariat that the Government of Uruguay has taken note of the measures adopted by Her Majesty's Government following the conclusions of the report of the Northumberland Committee, July notified to the GATT secretariat by the United Kingdom delegation on 4 September 1969.

The permanent delegation of Uruguay to GATT wishes to express to the GATT secretariat, and through it to the contracting parties to the General Agreement, that the Government of Uruguay reserves its right to put forward to the CONTRACTING PARTIES, according to the relevant provisions of the General Agreement, any problem that might derive from the adoption, at this instance, by the Government of the United Kingdom, of such measures following the conclusions of the report of the Northumberland Committee, if the present pattern of trade between the United Kingdom and Uruguay were to be at all altered to the disadvantage of Uruguay by virtue of the application, as from 1 October next, of the new import régime adopted by the Government of the United Kingdom.
