FOREIGN TRADE PLANNING OF POLAND

The Polish Government has transmitted to the secretariat, as background documentation for the forthcoming annual consultation under the Protocol for the Accession of Poland, the following extract from the Decree of the Diet of the Polish People's Republic of 22 December 1968 on the National Economic Plan for 1969, published in the "Monitor Polski", No. 54 of 28 December 1968.

IX. FOREIGN TRADE

1. The overall value of exports in 1969 is to reach 11,973 million zł. dew.¹, representing an increase of 10.1 per cent on the 1968 figure. The value of exports of machinery, equipment and means of transport is to reach 4,805 million zł. dew., representing an increase of 13.4 per cent on the corresponding figure for 1968.
2. The overall value of imports in 1969 is set at 12,446 million zł. dew. - an increase of 10.6 per cent on the 1968 figure. The value of imports of machinery, equipment and means of transport should reach 4,795 million zł. dew., representing an increase of 16.9 per cent on the corresponding figure for 1968.
3. It is expected that the structure of foreign trade in 1969 will be as follows (in per cent):
