PROVISIONAL ACCESSION OF THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

The Director-General has received a communication, dated 28 October 1969, from the representative of the United Arab Republic recalling that the Declaration on the Provisional Accession of the United Arab Republic will expire on 31 December 1969 and requesting that the necessary steps be taken to prolong the Declaration for a further year.

To facilitate consideration of this request at the next Council meeting, the secretariat has drawn up a draft proces-verbal extending the Declaration on provisional accession and a draft decision prolonging the invitation to the United Arab Republic to participate in the work of the CONTRACTING PARTIES. These drafts are annexed hereto.

A note on the present status of the Declaration is also annexed.

Annex 1

FIFTH PROCES-VERBAL EXTENDING THE DECLARATION ON THE PROVISIONAL ACCESSION OF THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC

Draft

The parties to the Declaration of 13 November 1962 on the Provisional Accession of the United Arab Republic to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade (hereinafter referred to as "the Declaration" and "the General Agreement", respectively),

Acting pursuant to paragraph 4 of the Declaration,

Agree that

- 1. The period of validity of the Declaration is extended for a further year by changing the date in paragraph 4 to "31 December 1970".
- 2. This Proces-Verbal shall be deposited with the Director-General to the CONTRACTING PARTIES to the General Agreement. It shall be open for acceptance, by signature or otherwise, by the United Arab Republic and by the participating governments. It shall become effective between the Government of the United Arab Republic and any participating government as soon as it shall have been accepted by the Government of the United Arab Republic and such government.
- 3. The Director-General shall furnish a certified copy of this Procès-Verbal and a notification of each acceptance thereof to the Government of the United Arab Republic and to each contracting party to the General Agreement.

Annex 2

FURTHER EXTENSION OF THE DECISION OF 13 NGVEMBER 1962 INVITING THE UNITED ARAB REPUBLIC TO PARTICIPATE IN THE WORK OF THE CONTRACTING PARTIES

Draft

Considering that the parties to the Declaration of 13 November 1962 on the Provisional Accession of the United Arab Republic to the General Agreement on Tariffs and Trade are taking steps, pursuant to paragraph 4 of that Declaration, to extend further the period of validity of the Declaration:

The CONTRACTING PARTIES

Decide to extend further the period of validity of the Decision of 13 November 1962, which provided for the participation of the United Arab Republic in the work of the CONTRACTING PARTIES, until the Government of the United Arab Republic accedes to the General Agreement under the provisions of Article XXXIII or until 31 December 1970, whichever date is earlier.

STATUS OF PROVISIONAL ACCESSION

The validity of the Declaration of 13 November 1962 on the Provisional accession of the United Arab Republic was extended by the Fourth Proces-Verbal of 19 November 1968 until 31 December 1969.
